1) KINDERGARTEN

First Step of Registration is, Prospectus is given at the time of registration and gives complete information about the School.

Eligible age: 2 plus i.e. 2½ to 4½ years by April.

Admission to Kindergarten will be through informal interaction with the parents and the child. Date and timing for interaction will be intimated telephonically.

List of selected candidates will be displayed at the School Administrative Office and parents will also be informed telephonically.

On confirmation of admission, parents will be required to deposit fee within seven days time.

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION –

- 1) Self attested photocopy of Birth Certificate of child issued by Nagar Nigam.
- 2) Family Photograph
- 3) Three passport size photographs

FOR CLASSES I – VIII

- 1) First Step of Registration - Prospectus is given at the time of registration and gives complete information about the School.
- 2) Admission to classes I & above is given based on the result of an admission test conducted by school.
- 3) Date, Time & Syllabus for admission test may be collected from school office at the time of Registration.
- 4) Result of Admission Test will be displayed at school office within 5 days of test

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED –

- 1) Filled up form and 3 passport size photographs.
- 2) Attested copy of Birth Certificate.
- 3) Original birth certificate for verification.
- 4) Report card of previous class (Attested).
- 5) T.C. (original) to be submitted within one month.
- 6) Caste certificate for SC / ST / OBC / EWS.
- 7) Certificate for Physical efficiency disability if any.

FOR CLASS TO IX -

- 1) Eligibility – Only students with minimum 60% aggregate score in class VIII OR Half Yearly Exam score will be calculated on the basis of four main subjects – English, Hindi, Maths, Science.
- 2) First Step of Registration is, Prospectus given at the time of registration and gives complete information about the School.
- 3) Written test in English, Maths, Science and interaction of students with the Principal.
- 4) Date, Time & Syllabus for admission test may be collected from School Administrative Office at the time of Registration.
- 5) Result of Admission Test will be displayed at School Office Notice Board within 5 days of test.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION –

- 1) Filled up form and 3 passport size photographs.
- 2) Attested copy of Birth Certificate.
- 3) Original birth certificate for verification.
- 4) Report card of previous class (Attested).
- 5) T.C. (original) to be submitted.
- 6) Original Character certificate.
- 7) Caste certificate for SC / ST / OBC / EWS.

ADMISSION TO X AND XII

- 1) Eligibility – Only Transfer cases accepted after qualifying Admission Test (Only For CBSE Students).
- 2) First Step of Registration is, Prospectus given at the time of registration and gives complete information about the School.
- 3) Admission is given based on the result of an admission test conducted by the school and the interaction of student with the Principal.
